FRESH & ARTIFICIAL FLOWERS: Permitted in the permanent bronze vase on the marker during the mowing season (April 1st – October 31st) *ITEMS NOT IN THE PERMANENT BRONZE VASE WILL BE REMOVED*.

WREATHS, CROSSES ETC. – Permitted November 1st – March 31st.

ANY ITEMS NOT PICKED UP BEFORE APRIL 1ST WILL BE THROWN AWAY.

Easter, Memorial Day, Mothers Day & Fathers Day: Special items can be placed on the Friday before the holiday and must be removed two days after the holiday. ANY ITEMS NOT PICKED UP WILL BE THROWN AWAY.

**Independence Day**: Special items can be placed after 5PM on July 3<sup>rd</sup> and removed July 6<sup>th</sup>. ANY ITEMS NOT PICKED UP JULY 6<sup>TH</sup> WILL BE THROWN AWAY.

**Birthdays & Anniversaries**: Special items can be placed the day before the special occasion and must be removed 2 days after. TO ENSURE THE ITEMS ARE NOT REMOVED YOU MUST NOTIFY THE OFFICE THAT YOU HAVE PLACED SOMETHING AND THE DATE OF THE OCCASION.

We will place all vases down on November 1st, if the vase is put back up during the non mowing season, we will make note, and we are not responsible for the vase freezing and cracking or any other damage to that vase.

Any flower arrangements in a plastic vase outside of the bronze vase will be removed. SIGNS, CERAMIC, GLASS BLOCKS OR VASES NOT PERMITTED AT ANY TIME. SOLAR DECORATIONS ARE NOT PERMITTED AT ANY TIME NO HANGING BASKETS OR SHEPHERD'S HOOKS ALLOWED AT ANY TIME. NO PLANTINGS OF ANY KIND PERMITTED

Unsightly or withered flowers, and misc. decorations will be removed.

**Flag Placement:** Permitted only on Memorial Day, Independence Day & Veterans Day. Flags can be placed 2 days prior to holiday and removed the day after the holiday. Metal emblem flag holders are permitted during the winter season and on the above listed holidays.

## MAUSOLEUM / NICHE REGULATIONS

Only ARTIFICIAL FLOWERS are permitted in the mausoleum. Be careful in your selection of flowers, as some may contain a dye that can deface the granite fronts. Crypt owners are responsible for replacing damaged fronts. It is recommended that artificial flowers be changed seasonally.

Flowers can not extend higher than 10" above the vase on the crypt fronts.

Do not attach photos, poems, letters, wreaths, etc. to granite, glass or bronze fronts.

Do not use adhesives or wire to attach items to any fronts.

THE CEMETERY WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PLANTS, VASES, FLAGS, OR FLOWERS OF ANY KIND DAMAGED BY THE ELEMENTS, THIEVES, VANDALS, OR BY OTHER CAUSES BEYOND OUR CONTROL.

The cemetery reserves the right to amend rules and regulations without notification. Cemetery regulations are like zoning regulations, which are made to preserve a community by limiting structures so that an appearance is maintained. Our regulations are established to preserve the appearance of our gardens and buildings.

We appreciate the support of the lot owners and encourage them to contact the cemetery annually for regulation changes or for information regarding decorations/regulations.
